## TRANSPORTATION GUIDELINES

## EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER $1^{\text {ST }} 2014$

Transportation within a fifteen-mile radius of the community will be provided free of charge at regular scheduled times. Please contact the Activity Director with any questions.

## THESE GUIDELINES HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED REGARDING TRANSPORTATION TO DOCTOR APPOINTMENTS:

1. Appointments should be made at least one (1) week in advance when possible. Please sign up for appointments with the nursing department.
2. If it is necessary to cancel your appointment please let nursing personnel know as soon as possible and have your name taken off the schedule.
3. Appointments should not be scheduled after 3:00 p.m. Schedule transportation days (Monday and Wednesday) are designated at each community.
4. The driver is not responsible to stay with residents at their appointments. If the resident needs assistance, they will need to make arrangements with a family member or companion to accompany them.
5. The community is not responsible for bills incurred by ambulance services or other modes of transportation used to transport a resident to an appointment or hospital visit.
*All residents residing in our memory care are required to have a family member or responsible party with them when going to an appointment. Please make arrangements to meet the bus at the appointment.
